As an Employment First state, the NJ Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) is working to ensure that competitive employment in the general workforce is the first and preferred post education outcome for all people with disabilities. This presentation explains the value of working in an integrated, competitive setting & provides information about ways to access DDD-funded employment services/supports.

Joseph Guarracino: *Rehab Counselor 2; The New Jersey Division of Vocational Services (DVRS) provides services that enable individuals with disabilities to find jobs. We also offer assistance to people with disabilities who are having problems keeping their jobs. With 19 locations throughout the state, DVRS is staffed by experienced rehabilitation counselors who provide valuable services to people who, as a result of physical, learning, mental, or emotional difficulties, need assistance obtaining or maintaining employment.*
