This Week in Math:

7th Grade Math students engaged in two different, fun activities to review and practice their knowledge of solving inequalities. Earlier in the week, the students learned about solving one-step inequalities before advancing to multistep inequalities, including use of the Distributive Property. The students also learned how to graph inequalities on a number line using open and closed circles. The activities that the students participated in included a math scavenger hunt where they had to solve and graph inequalities to find the next problem as well as card sort where they had to match problems with solutions. The students did a great job practicing the content as well as working with their partners to complete the activities. The students were able to recognize that there are many similarities to solving equations and inequalities other than the rule when multiplying and dividing by a negative number. Great job 7th grade math students, keep up the great work!
