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This Week in Math:

6th Grade Math students learned the order of operations this week! The students applied their knowledge of PEMDAS to evaluate numerical expressions that included parentheses, exponents, brackets, and operations as well as whole numbers, fractions, and decimals. The students practiced the order of operations as whole class, with partners, and independently. The students also learned the importance of parentheses in math and the impact that it can have on the value of an expression. Great job 6th grade, keep working hard!

7th Grade Math students learned the percent proportion and percent equation this week. In addition to these models, the students also used bar diagrams to represent different real-world scenarios. The students applied their knowledge of percent's to problems including tax on a meal, gratuity at a restaurant, and commission that a car salesperson makes after a sale.
