The students worked in groups of 2 or 3 to solve a real world application problem based on battery life of a cell phone. The students were initially engaged in Act 1 by watching a video of a student on his cell phone when suddenly he was alerted that he only has 20% battery life remaining. The students first came up with questions (both mathrelated and not) before identifying the main question that they would have to solve: "At what time did his phone die?". The students were then given additional information in Act 2 and worked in their groups to fine the unit rate, averages, use tables, etc. to approximate the answer. The students identified that there are multiple different strategies for finding the solution. The students finally watched a video in Act 3 where the main question was answered. Great job 8th grade, keep working hard!
