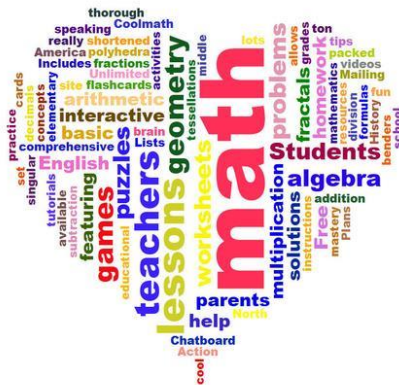

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This week in 8th grade math the students started graphing linear equations. They learned about slope and the y-intercept as well as equations in the form of $y=mx+b$. The students are using tables to identify coordinate points and plot them on the graph. The students are able to identify whether the equation and graph represent a proportional relationship as well as when the graph should and should not have arrowheads. Next week the students will be graphing without the table by simply using slope and the y-intercept. Great job 8th grade, keep working hard!

This week in 7th grade math the students were challenged with a problem where they had to use numbers 0-9 only once and apply their orders of operations to find the largest or smallest possible number. The 7th grade students not only practiced their math skills, but also their perseverance and persistence to solve a problem. Great job 7th grade, keep working hard!
