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This week in 8<sup>th</sup> grade math the students started graphing linear equations. They learned about slope and the y-intercept as well as equations in the form of y=mx+b. The students are using tables to identify coordinate points and plot them on the graph. The students are able to identify whether the equation and graph represent a proportional relationship as well as when the graph should and should not have arrowheads. Next week the students will be graphing without the table by simply using slope and the y-intercept. Great job 8<sup>th</sup> grade, keep working hard!

This week in 7<sup>th</sup> grade math the students were challenged with a problem where they had to use numbers 0-9 only once and apply their orders of operations to find the largest or smallest possible number. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade students not only practiced their math skills, but also their perseverance and persistence to solve a problem. Great job 7<sup>th</sup> grade, keep working hard!
