They have been identifying when to use which form and how each form can be used interchangeably. This week the students worked in groups to complete a discovery lesson. The students graphed multiple linear functions on the same coordinate plane and compared their slopes and yintercepts. In doing so, they discovered that the slopes of parallel lines are the same whereas their y-intercepts must be different. In addition, they discovered that the slopes of perpendicular lines are opposite reciprocals of one another whereas their y-intercepts could be the same or different. They did a great job with the discovery lesson and further wrote equations of parallel and perpendicular lines. Great job Algebra 1!
