Week of May 7th:

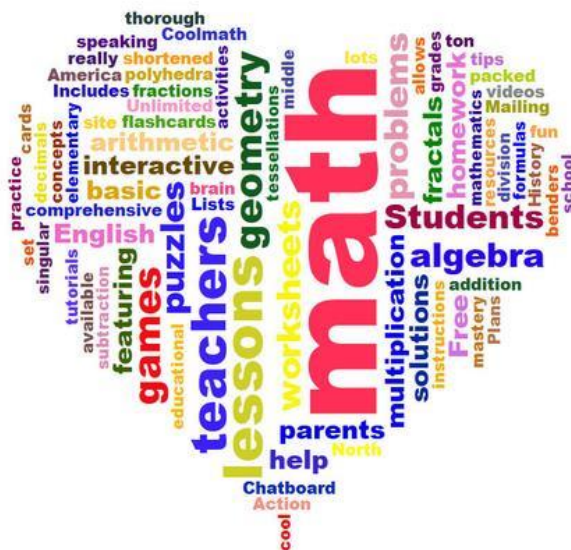

This week in 6th Grade Math:

The 6th grade students have been working extremely hard learning new topics. The students began the week in small groups learning about percent concepts and the relationship between percent, decimals, and fractions. The students continued over the course of the next two days finding missing information using the percent proportion. The 6th grade students were given basic problems and proceeded with more complicated real world application problems. Finally, the students were introduced to the data unit. Beginning with mean, median, mode, and range, the students were introduced to the information as a class and then practiced independently. In addition, the students found key words that would help them utilize the different data points such as **mode**-most and **median**-medium-middle. Finally, the students ended the week identifying statistical questions and completing an art activity to go along with it. Great job 6th grade!
