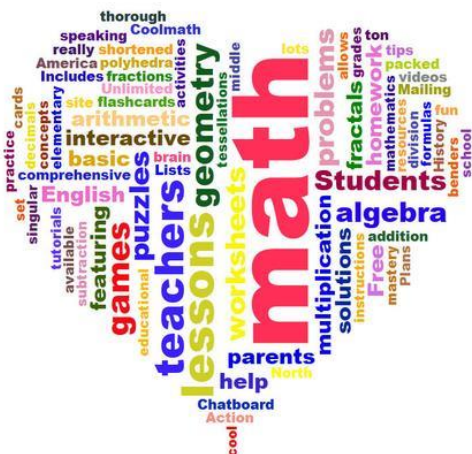

This week in 7th Grade Math:

The students in 7th grade math learned different methods for creating samples of a population: convenience, systematic, and simple random sampling. In addition, the students learned the difference between a biased sample and a representative sample. The students practiced using their online resource, created their own sampling problem, and solved a classmate's created problem. The students worked well independently, practiced their note-taking skills, and demonstrated knowledge of the topic. Great job 7th grade, keep up the great work!

This week in Algebra 1:

The students in Algebra 1 completed a discovery activity this week to identify the graph of a square root function. The students used their graphing calculators to discover transformations compared to the parent function in addition to identify parts of the equation.
