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## This week in 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Math:

The 6<sup>th</sup> grade students have been doing a great job in math learning about and putting into practice box-and-whisker plots, histograms, frequency tables, statistical questions, and mean, median, mode, and range. The students learned new vocabulary terms and identified different methods to visually represent data over the course of the last 2 weeks. During this time, the 6<sup>th</sup> grade students applied real world examples and created their own real world scenarios using actual data. Some examples included temperature in Avon-by-the-Sea, the price of hamburgers in NYC, and weights of different cat breeds. After creating their own problem, the students then answered their classmate's questions. The students demonstrated their knowledge with multiple formative assessments including worksheets, do now's, and Pearson lesson quizzes. The students completed a summative assessment during the middle of the week to apply all of the content that they obtained. Excellent job 6<sup>th</sup> grade, keep up the great work!
