This week in 7th Grade Math:

The 7th grade math students discussed probability in real world scenarios such as rolling a die that lands on 6, spinning a spinner with different colors and numbers, and pulling a sock from a messy drawer. The 7th grade students learned the difference between theoretical probability and experimental probability and how sometimes they may not be the same. The students discussed how to find the probability, or likelihood, that something happens as well as how to accurately find the fraction. In addition, the students reviewed converting a fraction to a decimal and a percent (a skill that was learned earlier in the school year). Great job 7th grade! Keep up the great work!

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
