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This Week in Math:

Algebra 1 students continued learning about solving equations, but took it a step further with literal equations. The students learned what a literal equation is and that literal equations are utilized in daily life with the use of different geometric and scientific formulas. In addition to literal equations, the students reviewed their knowledge of rates and ratios and applied this information to conversion factors. The students converted among units, and they used fractions, and unit analysis to do so. Great job Algebra 1 students keep working hard!

7th Grade Math students did a great job this week with a brand new lesson of operations with integers. The students learned different rules for each operation, such as when you multiply two negative numbers the answer is positive, and then further advanced their learning by applying this knowledge to rational numbers. The students did a great job with participation and engagement. Keep up the great work 6th grade!
