We completed our Wordly Wise Lesson 2 activities and our tests, practiced identifying singular and plural nouns, read our independent reading books, practiced penmanship, and responded to writing prompts. Next week, we will begin working with Wordly Wise Lesson 3 words and practice writing RAECT paragraphs. Word Study tests will be Friday, October 26th.
